# REPORT OF HOUSE RENOVATION OF Mr. & Mrs. ASOKAN (PARENTS OF DEMISED STAFF, AKHIL)

Akhil N A was the only son of Mr. & Mrs. Asokan. He had stopped his studies at the age of 18 and started working for the survival of the family. He had to shoulder the financial burden of the family, including the expenses of his only sister's marriage. He joined Rajagiri on March 2013 as Driver.

The socio economic situation of his family was gradually improving through his hard work and determination. However, a tragic turn of events resulted when Akhil succumbed to a rare disease within the course of five days. In spite of all efforts taken by the medical team of Rajagiri Hospital, Akhil passed away on Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> April 2016.

The college decided to extend support to his parents financially as well as emotionally to overcome from the crisis. Both the parents were unhealthy and hence their income was very meagre. The mother was engaged in coir spinning work and income was too low to make a living.

We recommended her for a job at Amala Public School, Kottarappally and she joined in the Housekeeping department of the school on 15<sup>th</sup> December 2016. Now the family gets a regular income and they are gradually recovering from their sorrow.

Akhil had a strong desire for the renovation of their incomplete house. It was a very small house with unplastered walls, floors and asbestos sheeted roof. They had no toilet facilities or any other basic amenities.

With the support of our well-wishers, we could complete the reconstruction of the house. The following works are being done:

#### **Existing building**

- Concreting of roof
- Plastering of walls
- Fitting of doors and windows
- Flooring (tiles)

### **Extension work**

- Kitchen
- Toilet,
- Work area and sit out

The renovation work was completed in the first week of April 2017 and housewarming was held on 14<sup>th</sup> April 2017. A total amount of Rs.5,50,000/- (Rupees Five Lakh Fifty Thousand only) was spent for completing the work.
